FOR TURF INSECT CONTROL: For the control of ants, Asiatic Garden Beetle Larvae, European Chafer Larvae, Japanese Beetle Larvae, White Fringed Beetle Larvae, White Grubs and Wireworms apply 40 lbs of Heptachlor 5% Granular per acre. Wash into the top few inches of soil. For the control of Green June Beetle apply 60 lbs of Heptachlor 5% Granular per acre. Wash into the top few inches of soil. Use only on ornamental turf. Birds feeding on treated areas may be killed.
