CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY if persons handling or working with Parathion develop poisoning symptoms.

FIRST AID TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED-give tablespoonful of salt in glass of warm water. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have victim lie down & be quiet. INHALATION-remove patient from contaminated atmosphere.

SKIN-in case of contact, remove contaminated clothing and immediately wash skin thoroughly with soap and water.

EYES-in case of contact, flush immediately with warm water for at least 15 minutes.

NFORMATION FOR PHYSICIAN-(Treatment)-give Atropine preferably by injection, grains 1/30 to 1/15 (2 to 4 mg.), at once every hour or oftener as needed to achieve and maintain full atropinization. Never give morphine. Clear chest by postural drainage. Artificial respiration or oxygen administration may be necessary. Observe patient continuously for 48 hours.


