DIRECTIONS FOR USE

TURF, LAWN: Brown Patch, Leafspot, Damp-Off, Root Rot: 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water. Apply 10 gals. to each 1000 sq.ft. of turf. Apply prior to infection. Repeat at 7-10 day intervals if necessary. Do not graze treated areas. Do not feed clippings to livestock.

ORNAMENTALS, ROSES: Black Spot; CARNATIONS: Rust and Leaf Spot; CHRYSANTHEMUMS: Flower Blight: 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water. Apply at first sign of diseases, cover upper and lower leaf surfaces thoroughly. Repeat every 7-10 days.

SOLIT AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENTS: Preplanting for Damp-Off and Root Rot Diseases on Seedlings or Transplants of Rosesterate other Shrubs and Trees), many Flowers and Vegetables (such as Beans, Peas, Curcubits) and Lawn Seedbeds. Apply as a dust at 2 lbs. per 1000 sq.ft. or spray at 14 lbs. per 100 gals. of water, using 15 gals; to each 1000 sq.ft. Cultivate into upper 3-4 inches of soil before planting.
