

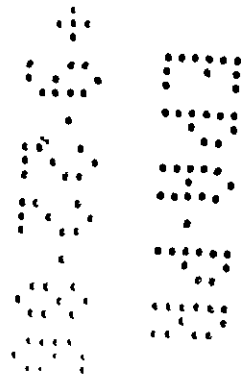

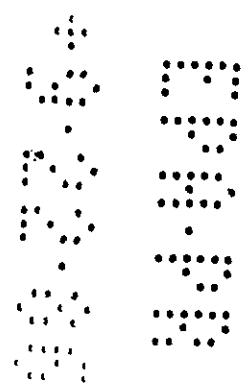
Container Disposal

RIGHT PANEL
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Apply Citra-Fec with a cloth, mop or mechanical spray device so as to thoroughly wet surface. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when used solution becomes visibly dirty.

"Disinfection in Hospitals, Nursing Homes and other Health Care Institutions."

For disinfecting floor, walls, countertops, bathing areas, lavatories, bed frames, tables, chairs, garbage pails and other non-porous surfaces.

Add 5 1/2 oz. Citra-Fec to 5 gallons water. Apply to previously cleaned hard surface with mop or cloth. At this use-level Citra-Fec is effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

"Disinfectant in Non-medical institutions (i.e. Educational, Penal, Military), Industry and Schools"

For disinfecting floors, walls, bedframes, countertops, tables, chairs, garbage pails, bathroom fixtures and other hard surfaces.

Add 2 1/4 oz. of Citra-Fec to 5 gallon of water. Apply to previously cleaned hard surface with mop or cloth.

At 2 1/4 oz./5 gallon use-level Citra-Fec is effective against Samonella choleraesius and Staphlococcus aureus.

"Disinfection of Poultry Hatcheries, Houses, Swine and other Animal Quarters and Kennels."

Poultry brooders, watering founts, feeding equipment, swine and other animal quarters (such as stalls and kennel areas) can be disinfected after thorough cleaning by applying a solution of 2 1/4 oz. of Citra-Fec in 5 gallons of water with a mop, cloth or brush. Small utensils should be immersed in this solutio..

Prior to disinfection, all poultry, swine, other animals and their feeds must be removed from the premises. This includes emptying all troughs, racks and other feeding and watering devices.

RIGHT PANEL

Remove all litter and droppings from floors, walls and other surfaces occupied or traversed by Poultry, Swine or other animals.

After disinfection, ventilate buildings. Coops or other closed spaces. Do not house Poultry, Swine or other animals or employ equipment until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

All treated equipment that contact feed or drinking water must be rinsed with potable water before reuse.
