ANTIDOTES

External: Wipe off acid gently, immediately flood surface with water using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

Internal: Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, whiting or small pieces of soap softened with water, in milk mucilage or raw egg white.

Eyes: Flush with water for a least 15 minutes.

CAUTION: Do not use cleaner full strength on bathtubs, sinks or other enameled surfaces. . . . Use only on toilet bowls and urinals.

DIRECTIONS

Please Read Carefully For Best Results To Remove Stains From Toilet Bowls and Urinals: Wet swab in water and press excess water out. Pour Bowl Cleaner on swab while holding swab over bowl. Clean surfaces and under flush rims. For Heavy Rust Stains Under Water Line: Remove as much water as possible. Pour 2 to 3 ounces of Bowl Cleaner into bowl, allow to work for several minutes, then use bowl swab to clean completely.

URINALS: To eliminate Urinal Odors: Shut off flushing water. Pour 6 or 8 ounces of Bowl Cleaner into urinal drain. Allow to work for at least 1/2 hour. Flush Thoroughly. If odors persist a second application may be necessary.
