

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For Sanitizing Dishes, Glassware, Utensils: Wash in a good detergent solution. Rinse in clear water. Place in a solution of 200 ppm for 2 minutes or for contact time specified by local sanitary code. Rinse thoroughly with potable water.

Hospitals & Household Use: For disinfecting floors, walls, tubs, shower stalls, water fountains, toilets, etc.: First clean with a good detergent. Disinfect with a solution of 400 ppm for non-porous surfaces and 800 ppm for hospital use and porous surfaces. Use 1 to 2 ounces to each gallon of water.

DIRECTIONS FOR DILUTIONS

200 ppm solution: 1 ounce in 4 gallons of water.

400 ppm solution: 1 ounce in 2 gallons of water.

800 ppm solution: 1 ounce in 1 gallon of water.
