

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Regular use keeps toilet bowls sparkling white. Excellent for brightening colored toilet bowls. Harmless to plumbing and septic tanks.

DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION: Raise toilet seat. Direct the thick liquid formula inside bowl, including under the rim, on the sides, and into water. Wet thoroughly, allow to remain 10 minutes. Flush. Rinse bowl brush in fresh water after use.

TO REMOVE STUBBORN STAINS: For hard water stains, follow directions above. Then apply more product directly to stained areas. Let stand at least 15 minutes, brush and flush. Repeat if necessary.

BATHROOM: Great for cleaning and deodorizing basins, tubs, and tiles. Leaves everything bright and clean... kills odor causing household germs. Odors disappear instantly. Use full strength where odors are a problem.

MILDEWSTATIC PERFORMANCE: Ready to use WHITE OCEAN FOAM will effectively inhibit the growth of mold and mildew and the odors caused by them when applied to hard, non-porous surfaces (as indicated above.) STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: INTERNAL - If swallowed, drink large quantities of water or milk. Follow with milk of magnesia, beaten eggs or vegetable oil. Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. **EXTERNAL** - In case of contact, flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for 15 minutes. For eyes, get prompt medical attention.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS-HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS-DANGER: Corrosive. Contains phosphoric acid. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Causes severe skin and eye damage.
