The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions:

Proposed Amendment

- Response to PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

1. Add the following statement to the Directions for Use

*Note: Do not mix with chlorine-type bleaches other chemicals

2. Delete the use site Kitchen from the Directions for use. The use site "Kitchen" was not included on the last stamped label dated December 21, 1990.

3. Revise the Precautionary Language as follows:

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield or safety glasses) protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

4. Reorder your First Aid Statements as follows: IF IN EYES, IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING, IF SWALLOWED followed by IF INHALED.

5. According to PR Notice 83-3 all products are required to have appropriate storage instructions. It appears that this product is distributed in 1 quart and 1 gallon containers. Revise as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Store in original container in a locked storage area in accessible to children. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and discard in the trash.

A stamped label is enclosed for your records. Please submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling. If the above conditions are not compiled with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section (e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Regular use keeps toilet bowls sparkling white. Excellent for brightening colored toilet bowls. Harmless to plumbing and septic tanks.

DISINFECTION & DEODORIZATION: Raise toilet seat. Direct the thick liquid formula inside bowl, including under the rim, on the sides, and into water. Wet thoroughly, allow to remain 10 minutes. Flush. Rinse bowl, brush in fresh water after use.

BATHROOM & KITCHEN: Great for cleaning and deodorizing all tile, stainless steel sinks, fiberglass shower walls/doors, basins, chrome fixtures, and toilet bowls. 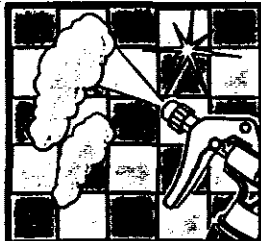

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

This product must be kept under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
