



### **OVERALL LAWN APPLICATION**

SHAW S Turf Care Granular Insect Control plus Lawn Food controls the following lawn insects on both grass and dichondra lawns: Chinch bugs - Earwigs - Ants - Lawn moths (Sod webworms) - Bermuda mites - Crickets - Armyworms - Chiggers - Clover mites - Cutworms - Leafhoppers - Sowbugs - Millipedes - Springtails (Collembola).

Apply SHAW'S Turf Care Granular Insect Control plus Lawn Food to your lawn with a fertilizer spreader at the rates shown. Application should be made when grass is dry. Water lawn lightly after application. Receat as necessary

Apply at the rate of 3.0 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (an area 20" by 50").

### BILL BUGS, WHITE GRUBS OF JAPANESE BEETLE, EUROPEAN CHAFER, SOUTHERN CHAFER

Apply 3.6 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn. Water grass thoroughly after application. For grub control make application any time between late July and early October. For billiding control, apply when activity is first observed or when chewed or brown grass indicates damage from these insects. Repeat as necessary.

### HYPERODES WEEVIL (NEW YORK ONLY)

Apply 3.0 lbs per 1000 sq. ft. of grass. Water grass thoroughly after application. Treat problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

NOTE. Above spreader settings are approximate. Check your spreader on 100 sq. ft. and adjust to apply 4.8 az. per 100 sq. ft. for the 3 fbs. per 1000 sq. ft. rate or 5.7 oz. per 100 sq. ft. for the 3.6 fbs. per 1000 sq. ft. rate. Rate of walk, moisture and spreader condition can vary the setting necessary to apply the correct amount.
