

FOR RATS—Place in shallow containers 4 ounces or more of Pandoro Rat & Mouse Bait No. 1 Ready Mixed Bait in places frequented by rats. The more rats you have the more placements and bait you should use. Replenish bait each day and replace any that has spoiled or is contaminated. Should all the bait be eaten it is evident not enough is being used. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 10 days.

Pandoro Rat & Mouse Bait No. 1 contains as its active ingredient an anti-coagulant chemical which if taken by humans, animals and pets may reduce the clotting ability of the blood and a serious hemorrhage may result. In case baits are eaten, **ANTIDOTE:** Give tablespoonful of salt in glass of warm water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: When a human has been known to have ingested Pandoro Rat & Mouse Bait No. 1, blood transfusions combined with intravenous injections and oral doses of vitamin K are indicated as in the case of hemorrhage caused by overdoses of Dicumarol R.

DIRECTIONS

FOR RATS—Place in shallow containers 4 ounces or more of Pandoro Rat & Mouse Bait No. 1 Ready Mixed Bait in places frequented by rats. The more rats you have the more placements and bait you should use. Replenish bait each day and replace any that has spoiled or is contaminated. Should all the bait be eaten it is evident not enough is being used. An uninterrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 10 days.

Baits can be placed behind boards leaned against walls. Use 1" by 8" boards four feet long. Fasten securely. Have bait placed about the center of the board. Baits should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets and domestic animals, or in tamper-proof boxes.

FOR MICE—Use tablespoon amounts ($\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{1}{2}$ ounce) of bait placed at 8 to 12 foot intervals. An interrupted supply of bait should be maintained for at least 15 days. Baits should be placed in locations not accessible to children, pets and domestic animals, or in tamper-proof boxes.

RATS or MICE—In badly infested areas a permanent feeding program should be maintained as long as evidence of rats or mice remain.
