Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the above named product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. The Precutionary Statements should read:

"Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. May be fatal is inhaled. Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear goggles or face shield. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.



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2. On the right panel above the word "DANGER" add the Heading "Precautionary Statements" and "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals".
3. The Statements of Practical Treatment should read:  
  
If Swallowed: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician or Poison Control Center.  
  
If on Skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.  
  
If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably, mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.  
  
If in Eyes: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.  
  
Note to Physician: Probably mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
4. Change the heading "General Directions" to read "Directions for Use".
5. Place "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" under the "Directions for Use".
6. Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:  
  
"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA".

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

#### GENERAL DIRECTIONS

All surfaces should be thoroughly cleaned before sanitizing with FS-101 solution containing 100 ppm available chlorine. If possible, parts should be submerged for two minutes or more. **DO NOT SOAK OVERNIGHT.** See Proportions of Use.

#### RECIRCULATION METHOD

Prepare 100 ppm available chlorine solution. Test to maintain a solution above 50 ppm available chlorine.

#### SPRAY METHOD

Spray all surfaces with 100 ppm available chlorine solution

#### FOR BEST RESULTS

Sanitize equipment just before using. Follow the complete IBA Sanitation Program Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

#### LOCAL, STATE REGULATIONS

Where local or state regulations are in effect, consult rules or your local authorities

#### PROPORTIONS OF USE

To prepare a 100 ppm available chlorine solution use 1 level teaspoon per 2 gal. water or 1 oz. of FS-101 to 18 gal. water

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store on side. Avoid creasing or impacting of side walls.

**DISPOSAL:** FS-101 wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess FS-101 mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If those wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office. Triple rinse (or equivalent), then offer for recycling or reconditioning or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

## DANGER
