DIRECTIONS

Make one or more applications as needed with no applications later than 21 days before harvest

GRAPES: Grape Leafhopper, Spider Mites, Mealy-Bugs, Mildew 20 to 30 lbs. per acre. Do not apply after grapes reach buckshot stage

COTTON: Aphis, Two-spotted Mite, Pacific Mite, Alantic Mite 25 to 30 pounds per acre

ORNAMENTALS and NURSERY STOCK: Two-spotted Mite, Soft Brown Scale, Aphids, Powdery Mildew 30 to 40 pounds per acre.

TOMATOES AND MELONS: Aphids and Spider Mites Repeat as needed 25 to 30 lbs. per acre
