The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided the following revisions are made to the labeling prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling.

- 1. The Statement of Practical Treatment for all Toxicity Category 1 poisons (Danger Poison) must be on the front (center) panel (see 40 CFR 162.10 (h)(1)(iii)).
- 2. The Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals text needs to be consolidated. Delete the fourth sentence "Do not breathe dust" since it is repeated later. Tove the sentence "Do not innale vapors or breathe dust" up to join the first paragraph and then continue on with the respirator sentence also in the same first paragraph.
- 3. Relocate the paragraph beginning "Do not contaminate feed or food" out from under the Note to Physician and move it up to be the second paragraph of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section.
- 4. With the relocation of the Statement of Practical Treatment to the center panel, it will be possible to join the two halves of the Environmental Hazards on to the left panel.
- 5. Add FOR AGRICULTURAL USE ONLY to the front (center) panel in 18 point type.
- 6. Delete "Calif. State Reg. No. 08434-50013-AA." Federal registration supercedes intrastate registration. You should contact the State of California to ensure registration in their state under the Federal EPA Registration number of 8434-33.

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- 7. Add "Cotton" between "germinating" and "seeds" in the paragraph starting "STAND-AID is a combination systemic insecticide...."
- 8. Delete "For seed treatment and application at planting" from the second paragraph under "IMPORTANT" and then relocate the remainer of this paragraph to appear as the new first paragraph of this "IMPORTANT" section.
- 9. In the Storage and Disposal section delete "Prohibit/ons" (Prohibitions) and realign sentences to margin.
- 10. In this same section delete the subheading "General" and the sentences associated with that subheading.

Submit five (5) copies of the revised amended labeling prior to release for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
