DANGER

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Rapidly absorbed through the skin. Do not get in eyes or on skin. Do not breathe dust. Wear protective clothing and cotton or natural rubber gloves. If cotton gloves are used, they must be laundered or discarded after each day's use. Do not wear the same gloves for other work. Rubber gloves should be washed with soap and water after each use.

Do not inhale vapors or breathe dust

Wear a pesticide respirator jointly approved by the Mining Enforcement and Safety Administration (formerly the U.S. Bureau of Mines) and by the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health under the provisions of 30 CFR part 11.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed — Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Keep victim prone and quiet. Give victim one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled — Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin — Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes — Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Call a physician in all cases of suspected poisoning.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

ANTIDOTE: Atropine Sulphate

2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Do not contaminate feed or food. Keep out of reach of children. Keep all unprotected persons out of the operating area or vicinity. Wash hands, arms, and face thoroughly with soap and warm water after using and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and hot water before re-use.

Furrow application at planting. Apply evenly in areas where a limited period of protection against insects is needed.

COTTON - For control of Aphids, Mites and Rhizoctonia solani (damping-off). Apply 10 to 18 ounces of product per 1000 linear feet of row at a row spacing of 40". Use 1000 linear feet of row may be applied on a row spacing of 40". Apply in the seed furrow at planting time. Do not use on crop not registered for PCNB in rotation on PCNB. Do not feed or graze foliage.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

temperature, moisture, and tillage should be favorable for good
germination. Under adverse conditions the plant stand may be
affected.

Furrow application at planting. Apply evenly in furrow. For use in
areas where a limited period of protection against early season pests
is needed.

COTTON - For control of Aphids, Mites and Thrips, Rhizoctonia
solani (damping-off). Apply 10 to 18 ounces of product per 1000
linear feet of row at a row spacing of 40". Use of 11 ounces per
1000 linear feet of row may be applied on a row spacing of 20" to

crop not registered for PCNB in rotation on PCNB treated soil. Do not
feed or graze foliage.

Subject: Amendment - Update Label
Dot-Son Brand Stand Aid
EPA Registration No. 8434-33
Your Application Dated January 28, 1983

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided the following revisions are made to the labeling prior to release for shipment under the amended labeling.

1. The Statement of Practical Treatment for all Toxicity Category I poisons (Danger - Poison) must be on the front (center) panel (see 40 CFR 162.10 (h)(1)(iii)).
2. The Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals text needs to be consolidated. Delete the fourth sentence "Do not breathe dust" since it is repeated later. Move the sentence "Do not inhale vapors or breathe dust" up to join the first paragraph and then continue on with the respirator sentence also in the same first paragraph.
3. Relocate the paragraph beginning "Do not contaminate feed or food" out from under the Note to Physician and move it up to be the second paragraph of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals section.
4. With the relocation of the Statement of Practical Treatment to the center panel, it will be possible to join the two halves of the Environmental Hazards on to the left panel.
5. Add FOR AGRICULTURAL USE ONLY to the front (center) panel in 18 point type.
6. Delete "Calif. State Reg. No. 08434-50013-AA." Federal registration supercedes intrastate registration. You should contact the State of California to ensure registration in their state under the Federal EPA Registration Number of 8434-33.

7. Add "Cotton" between "germinating" and "seeds" in the paragraph starting "STAND-AID is a combination systemic insecticide...."
8. Delete "For seed treatment and application at planting" from the second paragraph under "IMPORTANT" and then relocate the remainder of this paragraph to appear as the new first paragraph of this "IMPORTANT" section.
9. In the Storage and Disposal section delete "Prohibit/ons" (Prohibitions) and realign sentences to margin.
10. In this same section delete the subheading "General" and the sentences associated with that subheading.

Submit five (5) copies of the revised amended labeling prior to release for shipment.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
