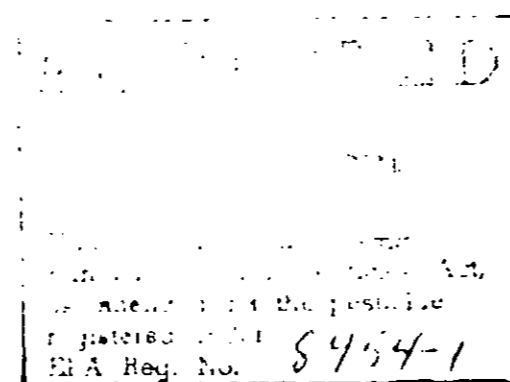


DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

If swallowed, drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE
PER 1000 GALLONS OF POOL WATER

IN A NEW OR OLD POOL SHOWING NO TRACE OF ALGAE pour 16 to 24 oz. into a gallon of water and dribble this into pool water as you walk around the pool. This will give you from 2 to 4 parts per million of active alkyl dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides. Thereafter put 4 ounces into pool water every 5 to 7 days in similar manner.

IN A POOL SHOWING SLIGHT TRACE OF ALGAE put at least 16 ounces into pool water in manner prescribed above. The next day vacuum settled algae, and then add at least 16 more ounces of Algae Kild. Thereafter, add 4 ounces every 5 to 7 days in similar manner.

If the above treatment does not aid in the removal of algae within a month, empty pool, scrub algae spots with a 5.25% household liquid bleach, or diluted 14% pool chlorine then scrub the spots with a pound of SEBRELL ALGAE KILD dissolved in warm water. Do not rinse off either the bleach or the SEBRELL ALGAE KILD treatment. When pool has been filled, follow procedure outlined for pool showing SLIGHT TRACES OF ALGAE.
