BAC-OFF Germicidal and Deodorizer is a powerful germicidal—effective against both gram positive and gram negative bacteria.

BAC-OFF effectively controls resistant strains of staphylococci ("Staph"); salmonella typhosa (Typhoid); shigella paradysoenteriae (Dysentery); salmonella schottmoeileri (food-poisoning); escherichia coli (Colon infections); micrococcus pyrogenus var. aureus, streptococcus pyogenes, streptococcus faecalis. It is also effective against fungi such as trichophyton interdigitale (hoths of Ringworm or Athlete's Foot).

BAC-OFF is an excellent deodorizer and chemically destroys odor producing bacteria. Reduces hazards of airborne infectious viruses.

Use BAC-OFF to deodorize surgical instruments, glass, tile, urinals, toilet seats, wash basins, shower stalls, both fixtures, telephones, hot irons, and springs, laundry chutes, door knobs, light switches, diaper pails, refuse and garbage cans and lockers.

Use BAC-OFF to sanitize and deodorize meeting rooms, class rooms, churches, sick rooms and restaurants.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Clean object to be sprayed using usual cleansing methods.

As a germicidal surface spray, hold dispenser upright and spray 6 to 8 inches from surface until surface is wet. Avoid contamination of food stuff.

As a deodorizer and air sanitizer, hold can upright and point valve opening away from face. Spray upwards into corner of room as well as center of room, filling room with mist.

CAUTION

Avoid contact with the eyes; if sprayed directly into eyes wash with water; if irritation persists consult your Physician. The contents of this container are under pressure. Do not puncture container nor dispose of same in fire or incinerator. Container should not be stored in direct sunlight or where temperature exceeds 120 degrees F. Do not wet varnished, painted or plastic surfaces with this spray.
