## Active Ingredients:

Diphenylamine - - - 15.0 %

Inert Ingredients: - - - - - 85.0 %

CAUTION: KEEP BUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN. Do not take internally. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. In case of contact wash skin or eyes with water. Dispose of waste solution in a manner that will not contaminate streams, ponds or any public water.
