## DIRECTIONS : AGRICULTURAL USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For use in protecting the following crops, scatter DEADLINE BULLETS on-to soil surfaces (only), around the plants.

SEED GRASSES : alfalfa, hay, wheat, oats, barley. Apply up to 40 lbs. per acre.

VEGETABLES : artichoke, asparagus, beans, beets, blackeyed peas, broccoli, brussels sprouts, cabbage, cantaloupe, carrots, cauliflower, celery, collards, corn, cowpeas, cucumbers, eggplants, endive, garlic, ginseng, horseradish, kale, kohlrabi, leeks, lettuce, melons, mustard greens, okra, onions, parsnips, peas, peppers, pimentos, potatoes, pumpkins, radishes, rhubarb, rutabagas, salsify, shallots, spinach, squash, sweet potatoes, swiss chard, tomatoes, turnips, watermelons. Apply up to 35 lbs. per acre.

TREE CROPS : citrus, avocado, cherries, peaches, apricots, apples, pears. Apply up to 40 lbs. per acre.

BERRIES : blackberries, boysenberries, caneberries, loganberries, raspberries, strawberries. Apply up to 200 lbs. per acre.

ORNAMENTALS : azaleas, camellias, rhododendrons, begonias, petunias, dahlias, impatiens, marigolds, iris, tulips, roses, daffodils, chrysanthemums, hydrangeas, ice plants, geraniums, sweet peas, honeysuckle, snapdragons, daisies, pansies. Apply up to 6 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.
