DIRECTIONS

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APPLICATION

FOR ROOF MOSS: Apply 1 gallon MOSS-STOP over 250 sq ft area, using sprinkler can or paint roller.

FOR HEAVY MOSS DEPOSITS: Apply 1 gallon MOSS-STOP over 200 sq ft area. Heavy moss can be raked off if desired, 10 days after application.
