

DIRECTIONS

This GERMICIDAL CLEANER is a disinfectant, a detergent, a fungicide, a deodorant, and a *viricide designed for reducing hazards of cross-infection on environmental surfaces in hospitals, nursing homes, and schools. This product can be used as a:

Disinfectant

At a 1 to 64 dilution (2 oz. to 1 gal. of water), it is an effective disinfectant and germicide. For best results, mop or wipe floors, walls, sink tops, rest rooms, garbage pails, and other hard surfaces. At this dilution it demonstrates bactericidal activity against Staphylococcus aureus, Salmonella choleraesuis, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.

Sanitizer-Deodorant

At a 1 to 224 dilution (2 oz. to 3½ gal. of water), it is an effective sanitizer when used on previously cleaned, hard surfaces.

This product fulfills the criteria of Appendix F, the Grade A Pasturized Milk Ordinance 1965 recommendations of the United States Public Health Service, in water up to 500 p.p.m. hardness calculated as CaCO₃, when tested by the A.O.A.C. Germicidal and Detergent Sanitizer Official Method.

Fungicide

At a 1 to 64 dilution (2 oz. to 1 gal. of water), it is effective against Trichophyton interdigitale strain # 640 (causative agent of athlete's foot).

***Viricide**

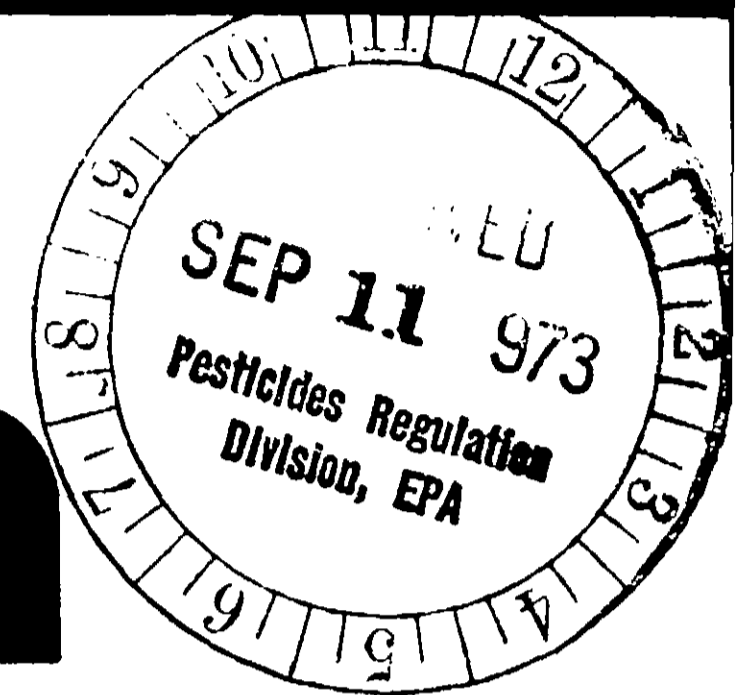
When used on environmental, inanimate hard surfaces at 2 ounces per gallon of water, it is effective against Influenza A₂, Herpes Simplex, Adenovirus type 2, and Vaccinia viruses.

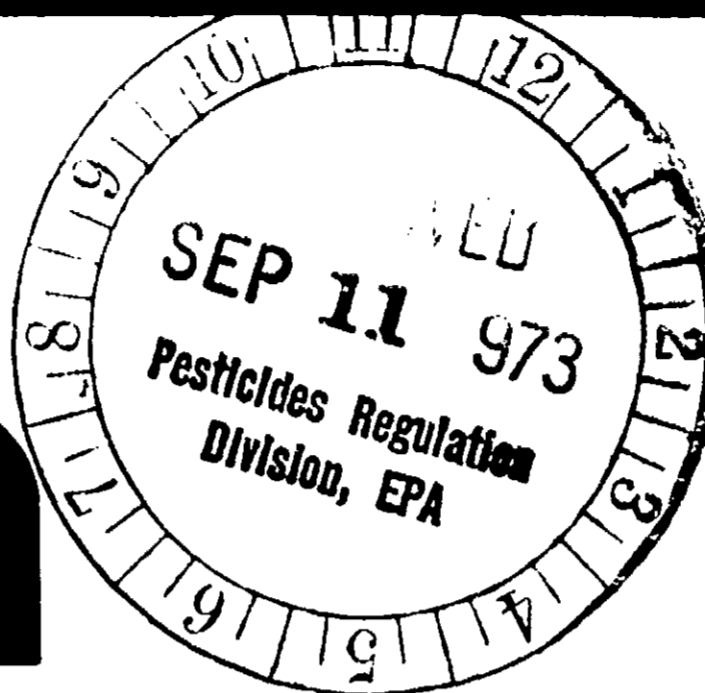

NET CONTENTS ONE GALLON

DANGER:
