WEEDS & PESTS CONTROLLED

W.F.A. Lawn Food with Weed & Insect Control is designed to give your lawn an effective feeding with maximum control of such lawn weeds as: Dandelion, False Dandelion, Plantain, Common Chickweed, Mouse Ear Chickweed, Bealall, White Clover, Japanese Clover, Spadewell (Vernonia), Buttercup, Lawn Daisy, and similar weeds. It will effectively control such harmful lawn pests as: Lawn moth, Sod webworm, Bill bugs, and White grubs.

DIRECTIONS FOR APPLICATION

1. Apply at rate of 10 to 15 pounds per 1000 sq. ft. of lawn area.
2. Spread two ways, being careful not to slip. (Cyclone type spreaders not recommended for application.)
3. Apply on established lawn only. Do not apply within drip line of trees and shrubs.
4. Lawn should be dampened either from dew or light lawn watering before application.
5. Do not mow lawn for two days before or three days following application.
6. Normal lawn watering may be resumed after 24 hours.
7. Do not apply to lawns where clover is a desired part of turf. Possible injury may occur if used on St. Augustine grass, Dichondra, Bentgrass, and Carpetgrass.
8. Occasional severe infestation of weed or insects may require repeat standard application spaced by one month.

CAUTION

Avoid inhalation of dust. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Avoid contact with vegetables, flowers, shrubs, ornamentals or other plants that are sensitive to 2,4-D, Banvel B and MCPP. Do not store near growing plants, fertilizers, seeds, insecticides and fungicides. Clean spreader after each use. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking.

ANTIDOTE

External: In case of spillage on skin, wash promptly with soap and water.
 Internal: Emetic of one tablespoon of mustard in tumbler of water. CALL A PHYSICIAN.
 Eyes: Flush with copious amounts of water. CALL A PHYSICIAN.
