Dear Ms. Belotinsky:

In the Agency letter of December 21, 2011, the Agency approved amended labeling for this registration with the condition that specific label revisions be made to the December 21, 2011 label stamped "Accepted with Comments". This letter further amends the December 21, 2011 label stamped "Accepted with Comments" by requiring one change to the December 21, 2011 letter.

1. Please disregard comment number 12 which says, "On page 39, reorganize the Storage and Disposal section to read as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
DO NOT CONTAMINATE WATER, FOOD, OR FEED BY STORAGE OR
DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area under lock and key. Post as a pesticide storage area.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance. When a cylinder is partially full, and there is no further requirement for the product, return the cylinder to the registrant or distributor. Replace safety cap and valve protection bonnet before shipping container.

Container Handling: Store cylinders upright, secured to a rack or wall to prevent tipping. Do not subject cylinders to rough handling or mechanical shock, such as dropping, bumping, dragging, or sliding. Do not use rope slings, hooks, tongs or similar devices to unload cylinders. Transport cylinders using hand truck, fork truck, or other device to which the cylinder can be firmly secured. Do not remove valve protection

bonnet and safety cap until immediately before use. Replace safety cap and valve protection bonnet when cylinder is not in use.

Return of Containers: Cylinders are the property of the manufacturer or distributor where purchased and must be returned promptly by collect freight. Do not ship cylinders without safety caps or valve protection bonnets.

Refillable Containers: Only the registrant or distributor is allowed to refill this container. Refill this container with pesticide only. Do not reuse this container for any other purpose. Cleaning the container before final disposal is the responsibility of the person disposing of the container. Cleaning before refilling is the responsibility of the refiller.

Container Disposal: To clean the container before final disposal, remove any remaining liquid from the container, using dry air pressure if necessary. Allow container to aerate for at least 5 days. After aeration, wash container using hot water; then offer container to qualified reconditioner or dispose of as directed by State or local regulations.”

The label associated with this change has been previously stamped “Accepted with Comments” and is dated December 21, 2011. Submit one copy of the final printed label that incorporates the required change before the product is released for shipment.
