



**DIRECTIONS:** 1. To establish the desired chlorine level of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm in newly filled pools, add to each 10,000 gallons of water: two (2) lbs. of SANI-CLOR Conditioner; two (2) oz. SANI-CLOR II Dry Concentrate Pool Chlorine. 2. Thereafter, to maintain the desired chlorine level of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm, add to each 10,000 gallons of water two (2) oz. of SANI-CLOR II Dry Concentrate Pool Chlorine every other day, or as needed. 3. For best results use a Sani-Test Kit or other suitable chlorine test kit frequently to maintain a chlorine level of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm and a pH of 7.2 to 7.6.

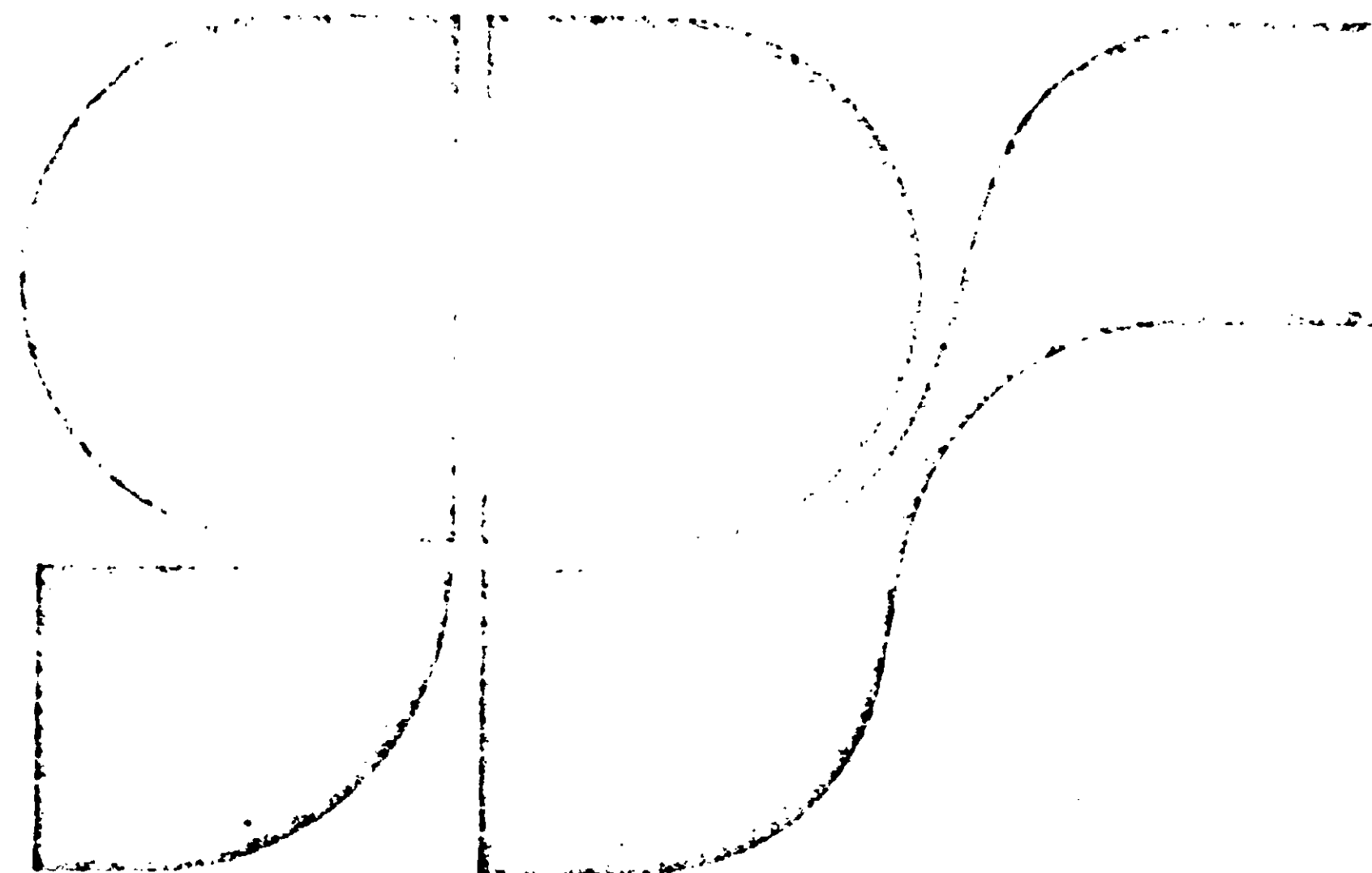
