DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Stir the pool with S.C. Conditioner. Allow the chlorine to settle. Add 20,000 (twenty thousand) drops of the S.C. Multiple Test Kit. Allow one pH and water sample to be taken every 24 hours as needed to monitor the available chlorine. Product degrades with age and time and increase dosage as necessary to return the required level of available chlorine. Maintain water pH at 7.2-7.6 as determined with a suitable test kit.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: STORE IN A COOL DRY AREA AWAY FROM DIRECT SUNLIGHT. IN CASE OF SPILL, FLOOD AREA WITH LARGE QUANTITIES OF WATER. DIRECTIONS FOR USE Stability: 100% in water. Add 1 quartian (300 ml) of the solution to 100 gallons (378 l) of water. Add the chlorine to the water in increments of 3 or 2000 mg of chlorine per gallon (0.3 ppm) increments. It is necessary to maintain a pH of 7.0 or higher. The pH of the water will decrease with age. Use a test kit to determine the pH of the water. If the pH is below 7.0, add a pH adjuster to the water. It is necessary to maintain a pH of 7.0 or higher to obtain the required level of chlorine. Maintain the pH at 7.0 or higher as determined by the test kit.
