DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Pool Start-up / superchlorination — add 3-1/4 quarts per 10,000 gallons of pool water (equal to 10 ppm available chlorine). Maintenance dosage is 11 ounces daily or as necessary to maintain residual in 1.5-3.0 ppm range. For spas, add 5-1/2 ounces per 1,000 gallons for start-up, superchlorination, and maintenance. Contact retailer for additional use directions.

Note: This product loses strength with age. Use a reliable test kit and adjust dosages as necessary to obtain required level of chlorine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, and public water unless in accordance with a NPDES permit.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Strong oxidizing agent. Mix only with water. Mixing with other chemicals or organic matter will release chlorine gas, irritating to eyes, lungs, and mucous membranes.

STORAGE, SPILLS, AND CONTAINER RETURN:

Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood area with water. Return bottle to dealer with closure tightly fastened.
