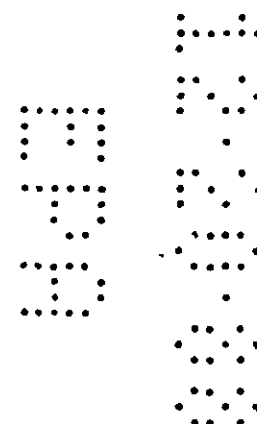

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Stabilize pool with Sani-Chlor pool conditioner (follow label directions). Add 1 quart of Sani-Chlor Pool Sanitizer to 20,000 gallons water, check available chlorine with suitable test kit. If below one PPM, add increments of 2 oz./20,000 gal. every other day or as needed to maintain 1.0-1.5 PPM available chlorine. Product degrades with age. Use a test kit and increase dosage as necessary to obtain the required level of available chlorine. Maintain water pH at 7.2-7.6 as determined with a suitable test kit.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams or ponds. Treated effluent cannot be discharged into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless a discharge permit is obtained. For guidance, contact the regional office of Environmental Protection Agency.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS: STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Mix only with water according to label directions.
