
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product
in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Pool water will accumulate a wide assortment of organic
wastes. Included in these wastes are hair sprays, body sweat, cosmetics, sunning
lotions, dust and falling leaves. All of these organic contaminants must be removed from
the pool on a timely basis and most of all when the pool has been used heavily. Jolt will
reduce these organic wastes in the pool and will make the water safe and clear.
Use Jolt at the rate of 1 lb. per 10,000 gallons of water. Add the entire contents of this
package into the water by broadcasting it over the entire pool area. Add Jolt only when
no one is in the pool. Jolt will give the pool a very high chlorine reading so make sure that
the chlorine level is below 3 ppm as determined by a test kit.
Swimmers should not be permitted in the pool after the Jolt treatment until the chlorine
residual is below 3 ppm as determined by a test kit.
In between Jolt treatments use your normal chlorine source to maintain a chlorine
residual between 1.0 and 2.0 ppm as determined by a test kit. Follow directions on label of
specific products used for this purpose.
To prevent any damage to vinyl lined pools pre-dissolve Jolt in a clean plastic bucket
with 2½ to 3 gallons of water. Never mix any swimming pool chemicals together. Wait at
least 30 minutes before adding another chemical.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep product
dry in tightly closed container
when not in use. Store in a cool
dry, well ventilated area away from
heat or open flame. In case of de-
composition isolate container, if
possible, and flood with large amounts
of water to dissolve all material before
discarding. Place in trash collection
or dispose in approved landfill area, or
bury in a safe place.
