

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER: Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles, gloves, and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to skin and the respiratory tract. Rinse eyes with water for 15 minutes if contact occurs.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to aquatic life. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water bodies. Do not discharge into the sewer. Do not discharge into the ground. Do not discharge into the air.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT: Strong oxidizing agent. May react with water use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such a mixture may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. Do not reuse container. If possible, isolate container. If not possible, isolate area. Flush with large volumes of water, if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Keep in original container. Do not use if container is not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat, fire, and flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container, if possible, and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area. Do not use for disposal.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE IN SPAS AND HOT TUBS

Temperature in spas and hot tubs has a substantial effect on the rate of chlorine available free chlorine in the water. The use directions for this product will differ for two sets of temperature variations. Of course, there is always a need for minimum available free chlorine to prevent bacteria and other contaminants. No matter what the temperature may be.

High temperature (90°F to 104°F)

Check free available chlorine with a Sani-Test test kit before entering the spa or hot tub. If below 1.0 ppm add 1 oz. (one cap full) of granules 2 for each 500 gallons of water. Add granules 2 by broadcasting over spa or hot tub surface. When a reading of 1.5 to 3.0% has been established as determined with a test kit, the spa or hot tub will be ready for use.

To maintain free available chlorine at high temperature, add 1 oz. of granules 2 each 30 minutes or as required to maintain 1.0 to 3.0 ppm of free available chlorine. Additions of granules 2 will depend on bather load and water temperature. Test spa and hot tub water frequently with a suitable test kit to assure a free available chlorine residual at all times.

Low temperature (90°F and below)
Check free available chlorine with a Sani-Test test kit. If below 1.0 ppm add 1 oz. of granules 2 for each 500 gallons. Repeat additions until free available chlorine of 1.0 to 1.5 has been established as determined with a suitable test kit. To maintain free available chlorine add 1 oz. of granules 2 for each 500 gallons daily or as needed to maintain 1.0 to 1.5 ppm free available chlorine. Always add product to spa or hot tub by broadcasting over the water.

IMPORTANT SUGGESTIONS

- Check and test the pH of the water with a suitable test kit. Maintain a pH of 7.2 to 7.6. If pH is above 7.6 add Sani-Chlor dry acid. If the pH is below 7.2 add Sani-Chlor soda ash. Follow label instructions on these products.
- Organic contamination of spa and hot tubs is a constant threat to proper sanitation. In order to destroy these contaminations you must Super Chlorinate the water in the spa and hot tub. This should be done weekly. It is good practice to use 10 times the dose that you normally use to sanitize your spa or hot tub. This is known as Super Chlorination. Do not enter the spa or hot tub until the free available chlorine is below 3.0 ppm. Test with a suitable test kit. The sanitizer, sanitation, and spray, and scaling from skin of bathers.
