Active Ingredients:
Distilled pine oil 10%
Vegetable soap 10%
Inert Ingredients:
Water 80%

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing, use 1½ ounces of Old Pine Tree to each gallon of water in mopping pail.

BATHROOM: Wash the bath tub, wash basin, and toilet seat and bowl (expel residual bowl water over the trap) with a solution of 1 ounce of Old Pine Tree to each quart of warm water.

LAUNDRY: For a cleaner, fresher wash on heavily soiled clothing, add ½ cup of Old Pine Tree to each washer load. Soak grease spots with 1 to 4 Solution Old Pine Tree to water.

DISINFECTING: First remove heavy soil and dirt, then soak surface to be disinfected with a solution of 1½ ounces Old Pine Tree to each gallon water. This will completely kill Salmonella typhosa bacteria.

DOGS: To aid in the prevention of fleas and odor, use solution of 1 ounce Old Pine Tree to quart of soapy, warm water. Wash dog, allowing soapy pine solution to remain on dog for several minutes. Rinse animal thoroughly.

GARBAGE CANS AND RACKS: To aid in the prevention of flies spray or sprinkle with solution of ½ ounce Old Pine Tree to quart of water and leave the solution in the can.
