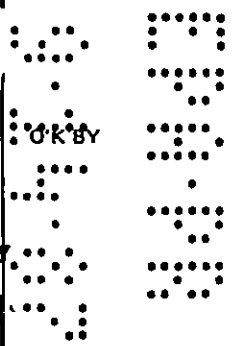
If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician.

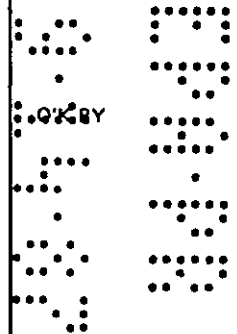

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

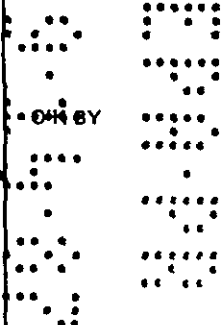
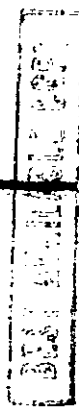
RE-ENTRY

Do not allow persons to enter treated areas within 4 days following application unless a long-sleeved shirt and long pants or a coverall that covers all parts of the body except the head, hands and feet and chemically resistant gloves are worn.

Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. 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DANGER

(Insert area or field description) treated with Captan on (insert data of application). Do not enter treated areas within 4 days following application unless protective clothing is worn. In case of accidental exposure; Call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to Captan and describe his condition. For further information see the "Statement of Practical Treatment".

Oral warnings must include the same information that is in the written warnings.

Captan 7.5D is a fungicidal dust formulation suitable for use by ground duster or airplane.

APPLES: Apple Scab, Brooks Fruit-Spot, Fly

Speckling, Bitter Rot, Black Rot, Botryosphaeria

30 to 35 lbs. per acre. Make first application

as soon as scab spores are ready to discharge and an infection period threatens. Repeat application for each subsequent infection period.

CANTALoupES, CUCUMBERS

Downy Mildew,

Angular Leaf Spot, Anthracnose. Apply at 25 to 30 lbs. per acre on young plants, increasing to 35 lbs. per acre on mature plants. Apply at first sign of disease. Repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals until danger of infection is past.

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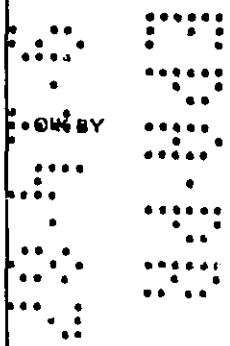
ORNAMENTALS: ROSES, Black Spot; CARNATIONS, Rust and Leaf Spot; CHRYSANTHEMUMS, Flower Blight.

Apply at first sign of disease to give even coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as necessary.

PEACH, NECTARINES: Brown Rot and Peach Scab. 50 lbs. per acre. Make 2 to 3 pre-bloom applications. Repeat at petal fall and 3 to 4 covers as necessary. Make pre-harvest application where necessary. Do not apply within one day of harvest.

SOIL AND GREENHOUSE BENCH TREATMENT: Preplanting for Damp-off and Root Rot Diseases on Seedling or Transplants of Roses (and other shrubs and trees), Many flowers, Cucumbers & Cantaloupes and lawn seedbeds - 1½ to 2½ lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. (50 to 60 lbs. per acre). Work into upper 3 or 4 inches of soil before planting.

Only the applicator is permitted to be in the greenhouse during application of captan. Open vents to greenhouse during application and for at least 1 hour after application.

Workers planting in captan-treated soil must wear chemical resistant gloves.

TIMING OF APPLICATION: Timing and rate of application vary as a result of local conditions.

Since these conditions are unknown to the manufacturer, you must satisfy yourself as to local requirements. Do not exceed maximum rates or use closer to harvest than specified above.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL (12 pt)

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

STORAGE: Store unused product in original container only. Store in a cool, dry area preferably locked and out of the reach of children and animals. Not for use or storage in or around the home. Protect from excess heat.
