**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**  
It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Read the entire label and use this product in accordance with all precautions and directions.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**  
Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not use empty container. After use, wrap container and put in trash collection.

**IMPORTANT FOR PROPER USE**  
Use one can for each 1,000 cubic feet (ten area 30 x 25 ft) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for rooms or where bee hives or fish are housed.

This product will kill Ticks, Fleas, Roaches, Ants, Spiders, Flying Moths, and Fleas and Ticks. Remove any bedding, pet and bedding. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered flea control product prior to re-entry.

Some surfaces may soften some finished surfaces. Avoid use. Drape newspaper over any item to avoid possible staining of finish. Use waxed wood floors and waxed furniture. Some plastic items may be affected by the solvent and a questionable cover with paper.

Place cans in center of area to be treated. Unfold several layers of newspaper and place in middle of room on floor. Open cabinets and doors to areas to be treated and fogged. REMOVE PETS. Cover fish tanks or bowls and shut off aerators. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Keep at arms length when releasing fogger. Fogger will fog room fast when released.

**TO STAY FOGGED:** Push down securely on valve in back and blow valve into locked position. Put can in upright position in middle of newspapers and leave area at once. Leave unobstructed for at least four hours. Then open doors and windows and allow to air for 12 hours. Heavy flea infestation may necessitate repeat fogging in 10 days for already hatched fleas, if necessary.

**CAUTION**

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**  
Inhalation - Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting if you are pregnant or nursing an infant.

Ingestion - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.

In skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

In eyes - Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Do not use if contaminated food processing, feeding, serving, storage or preparation area in the home or food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment and thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Remove pets, birds and livestock from area before spraying.
