Applications should not be made during periods of high temperature because dichlone may cause injury to apples. To avoid excessive residues, do not apply within 14 days of harvest. When applications are made by airplane or helicopter, apply approximately 2 to $2\frac{1}{2}$ lbs. per average-sized tree. When applications are made by ground equipment, apply approximately 3 lbs. per average-sized tree (75 lbs./Acre). Repeat at 10-14 day intervals as necessary for control.

APPLES: To aid in control of scab, Brook's fruit spot, sooty blotch, fly speck, coddling moth, plum curculio, red banded leaf rollers, bud moth, aphids, and mites. Applications may be made during the pre-blossom period and after petal fall, up to 15 days of harvest. Do not apply during blossom period to avoid injuring bees. Full-coverage applications by airplane or ground duster are necessary for satisfactory control. Use 40 pounds per acre. Do not apply more than 8 times per season.

CAUTION: Do not apply within 15 days of harvest. Remove residues remaining on fruit at harvest by washing, wiping, or other effective means. Do not apply to apples within 10 days of an oil spray. Use cautiously on Red Delicious and Baldwin varieties inasmuch as wettable powder sprays with captan have sometimes caused injury to the foliage of these varieties.
