**APPLES:** For control of Apple Scab, Bitter Rot, Brooks Fruit Spot, Fly-Speck, Frog Eye Leaf Spot, Codling Moth, Green Aphid, Maggot, Curculio, Red-banded and Fruit Tree Leaf Rollers, Cicada, Bud Moth and Japanese Beetle.

This material is recommended primarily for use as third cover and later cover applications. Apply on a protective schedule. Apply 35 to 40 pounds per acre by aircraft or suitable ground equipment as third cover application and repeat at 10 to 14 day intervals as necessary.

**CAUTION:** Application within 30 days after full bloom may also provide fruit thinning. For fruit thinning, do not use until at least 30 days after bloom. Do not use on Apples within 10 days of an oil spray. May cause leaf spotting on Red Delicious and Baldwin varieties. Do not apply to apples within 1 day of harvest.
