WOODY PLANTS: For control of Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, Poison Sumac, Tree Sprouts, Bramble and other Brush—Apply as a drenching spray anytime after the foliage reaches full leaf stage and until foliage begins to discolor due to frest. Wet foliage thoroughly. For best results, spray during periods of high humidity. Respray if any recovery is noted.

Rate: Nik 1 to per gallon of water.

PRETATION ON DINNEWAYS, WALKS, TENNIS EGURTS AND SIMILAR LOCATIONS: Apply uniformly with a sprinkling can or sprayer. The degree of control and duration of effect will vary with weed species, rainfall, temperature and other conditions.

Usually one gallon of the spray solution will cover 250 sq. ft., or use approximately 2 gallons of spray for a tree with a spread of 25 feet. For Poison Ivy growing on tree trunks, apply spray only if the bark of the tree is well developed and shows no green. Avoid excessive wetting of the bark as injury may result. Do not allow spray or drift to contact tree foliage or fruit as injury will result.

Rate: Mix .6 lb. or 1 cupful per gallon of water.

TO PREVENT SPROUTING OF TREE STUMPS: Apply dry "Ammate" X liberally on freshly cut stump surface especially around the outer edge, or spray surface thoroughly.

Rate: Mix 4 lbs. per gallon of water.

TO KILL UNDESIRABLE TREES: Make a continuous cut or "frill" around the base of the tree with downward axe strokes, cutting into the sapwood.

Rate: Apply dry "Ammate" X as a continuous band in the frill with solution of 4 lbs. of "Ammate" X per gallon of water.

IMPORTANT: Wash sprayer thoroughly after use to remove all "Ammate" X and to reduce corrosion. "Ammate" X absorbs moisture readily; keep package tightly closed.
