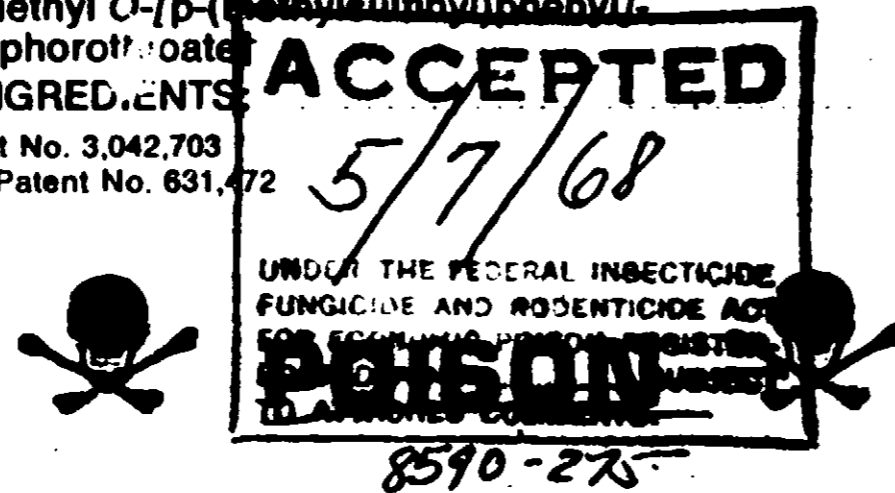

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin! Rapidly absorbed through skin! Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water before eating or smoking. Rinse equipment and containers and dispose of wastes by burying in non-crop lands away from water supplies. FIRST AID TREATMENT: SYMPTOMS: A sense of "tightness" in the chest, sweating, contracted pupils, stomach pains, vomiting and diarrhea. **TREATMENT:** In case of poisoning call a physician immediately. Have patient lie down and keep quiet. If swallowed, induce vomiting by giving a tablespoonful of salt in a glass of warm water. Administer milk or water freely and again induce vomiting until vomit fluid is clear. If on skin, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water. If eyes are contaminated, wash with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: ANTIDOTE: Administer atropine sulfate in large therapeutic doses. Repeat as necessary to the point of toler-

ance. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

Compound inhibits cholinesterase resulting in stimulation of the central nervous system, the parasympathetic nervous system, and the somatic motor nerves. Do not give morphine. Watch for pulmonary edema, which may develop in serious cases of poisoning even after 12 hours. At first sign of pulmonary edema, the patient should be placed in an oxygen tent and treated symptomatically.

DRY BULB ONIONS: In North Central and Northeastern states only, to control both onion maggot and onion smut apply Thiram-Tinasad 7.5-5 G evenly in the furrow at the time of seeding, as follows:

Row Spacing	Amount of Thiram-Tinasad 7.5-5 G/ 1000 ft. of row
18"	10 ozs. REGARDLESS of row spacing*

*For extremely narrow row spacing, do not exceed the 20 lbs. per acre rate.

The above rates will provide 20 pounds of Thiram-Tinasad 7.5-5 G per planted acre. Do not use in conjunction with pelleted seed. Do not apply to green bunch onions. This formulation contains individual granules covered with both an insecticide and a fungicide.
