

ORCHARD MOUSE BAIT-COATED

A wax coated cracked corn bait for control of meadow mice (Microtus pennsylvanious) for use only in the orchards of New England, New York, New Jersey and areas of similar environmental conditions.

BROADCAST BAITING: Apply with a mechanical seeding device. Use 8 to 10 lbs. bait per acre. Scatter bait evenly on both sides of tree at the drip line of the branches. Do not apply to bare soil. Watch the weather and try to bait during periods of fair weather.

Apply immediately after harvest, before leaves fall, grass and weed growth mat down. The application can be repeated if necessary.

NET WEIGHT

Hand Treating of Trails: Later in the fall after rains or the first snowfall have matted down the cover or weeds, locate the trails or runways established by the rodents. Treat each quarter of the tree by carefully opening the weeds or grass over the runway and placing one teaspoon of bait in surface trails or at the mouth of holes leading to underground borrow systems. Do this for each quarter in several places at 1 to 2 foot intervals. Baiting should be conducted at the rate of 2 to 3 pounds per acre. Orchard Mouse Bait — Coated should be applied immediately after harvest before leaves fall, grass and weed growth mat down, unless trail baiting by hand is to be practiced.

AIRPLANE BAITING: Apply 8 to 10 lbs. bait per acre. Do not apply over roadways. Other conditions apply as per broadcast baiting.

NOTE: This pesticide is to be sold ONLY in this original unbroken package.
