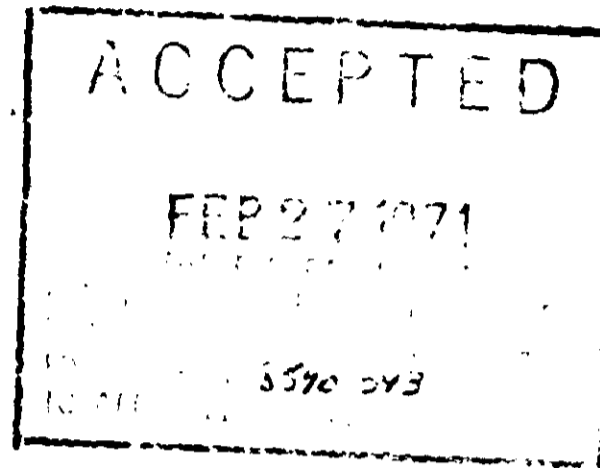

GENERAL—TIMING AND RATE: For best results make weekly application of dust throughout the growing season. Dust thoroughly covering both the upper and lower sides of the leaves. The first application should be applied early spring when the young leaves first appear. Use 10 oz. of dust per 625 square feet. A light deposit of dust is adequate. Do not over-treat.

ROSES: For control of Blackspot, Powdery Mildew, Japanese Beetles, Aphids, Mites, Thrips, Plant Bugs, Leafhoppers, and Rose Chafers and Slugs. Apply lightly when conditions are favorable for good coverage, as outlined under General Information.

CHRYSANTHEMUMS AND IRIS: For control of Septoria and Didymella leaf spot, Aphids, Thrips, Leafhoppers and Mites. Start applications immediately after transplanting and repeat at weekly intervals as needed throughout the growing season.

ZINNIAS, MARIGOLDS, CHRYSANTHEMUMS, ASTERS, FLOX AND SNAP DRAGONS: For control of Alternaria leafspot, Powdery Mildew, Anthracnose, Aphids, Mites, Thrips and Leafhoppers. Apply as outlined under General Directions.

CRAB APPLES (FLOWERING-ORNAMENTALS): For control of Scab, Mites, Aphids, Japanese Beetles, Gypsy Moths, Tent Caterpillars, Lace Bugs, and Bag-worms. Apply 16 ounces of dust per mature tree. Apply the first application when first leaves appear and repeat at weekly intervals until 30 days after petal fall for Scab control. For insects, repeat as necessary for control.

AZALEAS, BOXWOOD, ANDROMEDA: For control of Lace Bugs, Mites and Aphids. Apply when insects are first noticed and repeat at weekly intervals as necessary.

OPERATION OF GUN: This can is an efficient dust can. No other gun is needed. Before operating, open cap. Aim the nozzle so that dust is directed to under side or top of leaves as desired. The squeeze regulates amount of dust emitted. Close cap after use.
