Directions for Use

This fertilizer is especially prepared for control of the following surface feeding lawn insects:

Application on established turf: Apply uniformly at the rate of 7-1/2 lbs per 1,000 sq ft. Apply when lawn is dry.

Apply during May or June for surface feeding insects.

Establishing new lawns: For the control of surface feeding insects listed above, broadcast uniformly over the soil surface at the rate of 7-1/2 lbs per 1,000 sq ft. Work this into the top three inches of soil. Treat when the soil is in good seeding condition.

To control root feeding insects, white grubs (such as Japanese beetle, Chafer beetle and Phyllophaga spp.):

Application on established turf: Apply uniformly at the rate of 9 lbs per 1,000 sq ft. Apply when lawn is dry. Make application in August or September.

Establishing new lawns: For the control of root feeding insects listed above, broadcast uniformly over the soil surface at the rate of 9 lbs per 1,000 sq ft. Work this into the top three inches of soil. Treat when the soil is in good seeding condition.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes, flush eyes with plenty of water. See a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Carbaryl is a moderate, reversible cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.
