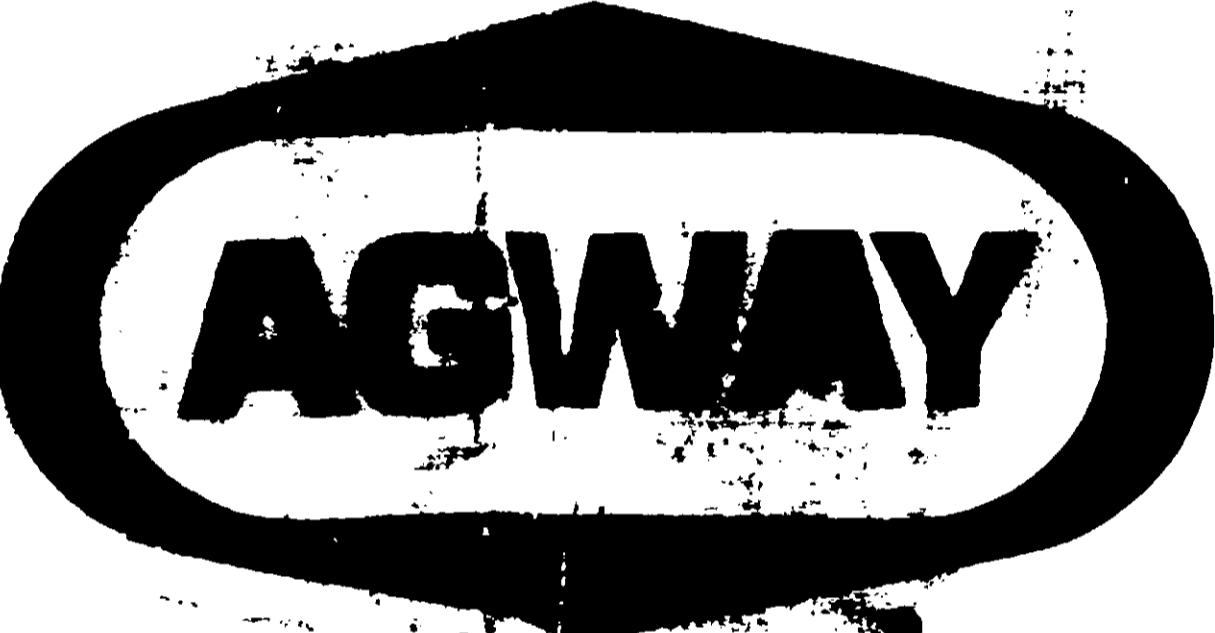

LICENSING AND HORN FLY CONTROL:
 Suspend 1% Dairy Duster in areas frequented by cattle or in passages or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in feeding sheds or in front of pastures and mineral feeders. For maximum fly control, 1% Dairy Duster may be suspended in the dark trough which cows leave the morning barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the level of the cattle.

INSTALLATION OF DAIRY DUSTERS:
 Suspend the bag by the hanging rope, chain, or wire through the eyelets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by the eyelets in the grommets into hooks fixed to stationary overhead structure. At the height receiver extend the hose and horn fly control areas of trough or hazy trough. 1% Dairy Duster should be protected from the weather.
 Install as many 25 pound 1% Dairy Dusters as necessary in lanes or other passages to ensure proper dusting of the animals. After the bags are in place, pull the top cord to allow the insecticide to fall into the bottom of the bag. When dust bags are provided on a free-choice basis, offer one 25 pound 1% Dairy Duster per 25 to 50 animals.

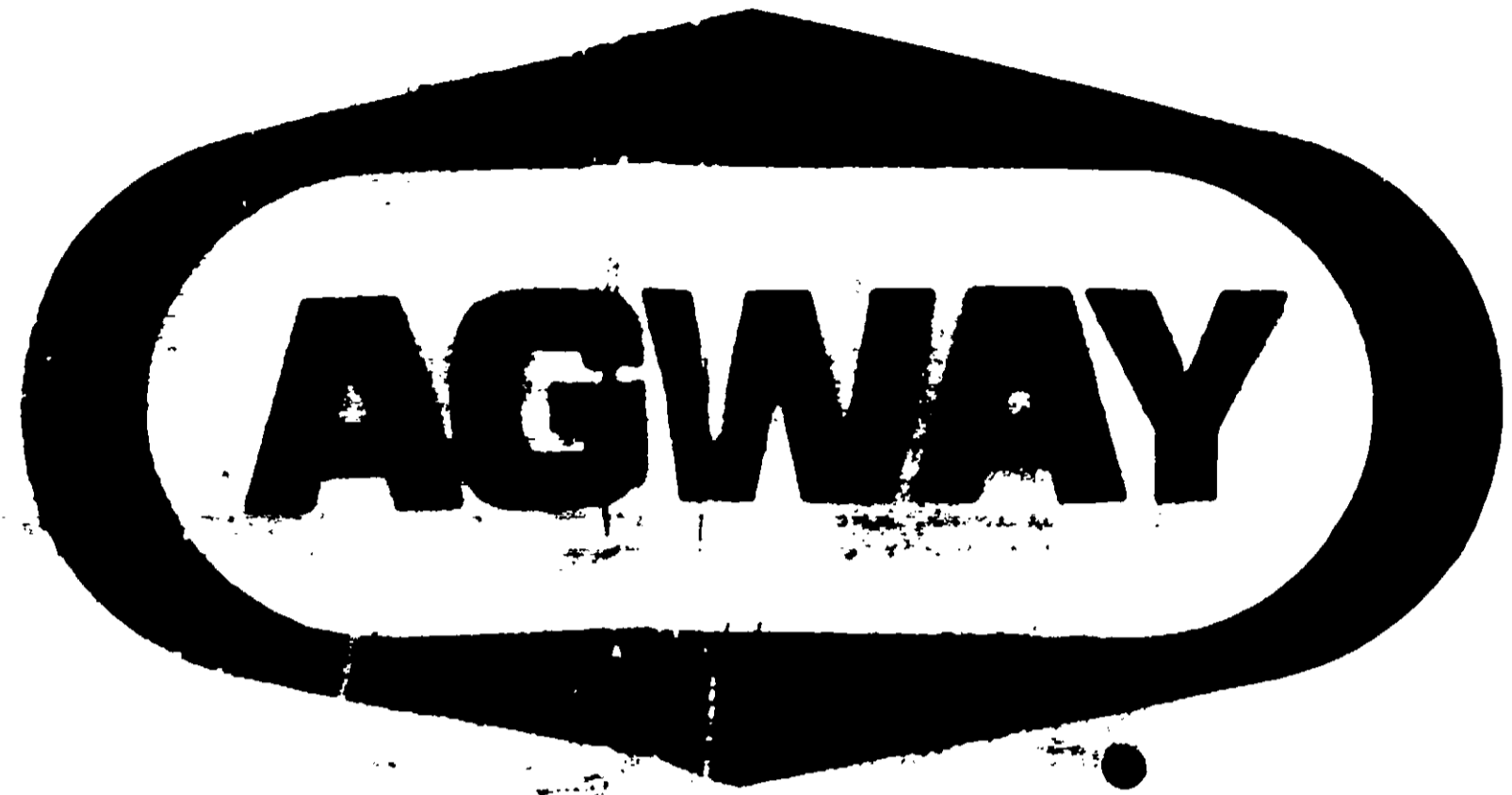

LICHT AND HORN FLY CONTROL:
 Suspend 1% Dairy Duster in areas frequented by cattle or in gateways or lanes through which the animals pass daily for water, feed or mineral. Bags may also be suspended in loafing sheds or in front of protein and mineral feeders. For lactating dairy cows, 1% Dairy Duster may be suspended in the exit through which cows leave the milking barn. In all cases, the bags should be adjusted so that the bottom of the bag will hang four to six inches below the top of the cattle.

INSTALLATION OF DAIRY DUSTERS:
 Suspend the bags by using rope, chain, or wire through the grommets at the top of the bag and attaching to an overhead structure or by fastening the grommets into hooks fixed to a stationary overhead structure at the heights recommended for louse and horn fly control in areas of frequent or heavy rainfall. 1% Dairy Dust should be protected from the weather. Install as many as 25 pound 1% Dairy Dusters as necessary in lanes or other corridors to assure proper dusting of the animals. After the bags are in place, pull the rip cord to allow the insecticide to fall into the bottom of the bag. When dust bags are provided on a free-choice basis, allow one 25 pound 1% Dairy Duster per 25 to 50 animals.
