## DIRECTIONS

READ THESE ENTIRE DIRECTIONS AND WARRANTY OF SALE. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL CAUTIONS, WARNINGS AND DIRECTIONS.

**WIREWORMS** (White Grubs): (Tomatoes, Strawberries, Sugar Beets): Apply to ground before planting in the spring at the rate of 15 lbs. per acre in any quantity of water necessary to give even coverage. After application work well into the soil by disking thoroughly in both directions.

For Ants, White Grubs and Japanese Beetle Grubs, in lawns and ornamental turf—Spray 25 pounds in 100 gallons per acre. Work into the soil or drench thoroughly with water.

**TERMITES:** a. **General ground treatment** (in crawl spaces and under slabs). Mix 1 lb. of Chlordane 40 W in 5 gallons of water. Use 1 gallon of this mixture per 10 square feet of surface. Two gallons per 10 linear feet should be applied around inside of building in critical areas including cracks and breaks in concrete or masonry.

b. **Trench treatment** inside foundations, trenches less than 15 inches deep apply 2 gallons per 5 linear feet. Outside foundations, trenches should be dug 30 inches deep but not below the top of the footing if this is shallower. For trenches less than 15 inches deep apply 2 gallons per 5 linear foot of trench. For trenches 15 inches deep or deeper apply 4 gallons per 5 linear foot of trench. The drench should be applied to the base of the trench and to the fill dirt.

**CUTWORMS:** Beans, corn, eggplant, lettuce, pepper, potatoes, and tomatoes. Apply 2½ lbs. per 100 gallons water, (150 gallons per acre) before planting. Apply evenly over the soil surface and do not disturb soil for 3 to 5 days.

**CAUTION:** Do not allow children or pets to go on treated lawn until the insecticide has been washed off the grass by sprinkling or drenching and the treated areas have dried thoroughly.
