Foxtail and Barnyard grass in newly seeded or established plantings of the following turf grasses: Bluegrass, Fescue, Redtop, Smooth Brome, Perennial Ryegrass, Orchardgrass, and the following strains of Bentgrass: Pennsylvanian, Seacliff, Highland, Astoria, Minutia, C-1, C-7 and C-18. Do not use on other Bentgrass strains, Zoysia, Dichondra or Bermudagrass, as injury to turf may result. Apply on a calm day to avoid wind drift.
