APPLICATION ON ESTABLISHED TURF OR HOME LAWNS: For the control of self-inhabiting insects such as ants, fall armyworm, chinch bugs, grasshoppers, flies, leaf hoppers, lesser meadow grasshopper, millipedes, meadowflies, broadcast turfood 10-6-4 with insect killer uniformly with lawn fertilizer spreader at rate of 20 pounds per 1,000 square feet (435 lbs. per acre). Apply when lawn is dry.

Three over-all lawn applications of Turfood 10-6-4 with insect killer per year in April, June, and August will control insects that damage lawns, both surface feeding pests as well as those that damage the roots, and at the same time provide the necessary plant food to the grass for a luxuriant lawn. This maintenance program, with applications in April, June, and August, is recommended for best results.

ESTABLISHING NEW LAWNS: For the control of self-inhabiting insects listed above, broadcast uniform y over soil surface with lawn fertilizer spreader at rate of 20 pounds per 1,000 square feet (435 lbs. per acre). Work this into the top three inches of soil. Treat when soil is in good seedling condition.
