

**OUTDOORS -- TO PROTECT ORNAMENTAL PLANTS:**

Kills aphids, exposed thrips, leathoppers, two-spotted mites, plant bugs, Japanese beetles on smaller rhododendrons, pines, spruce, hemlock, spirea, dogwood, palm, mimosa, toyon, viburnum, euonymus, oaks, maples, locust, forsythia and althea. Kills mimosa webworm larvae on mimosa. Spray directly on insects.

Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, leafhoppers, two-spotted mites, spittlebugs and Japanese beetles on peonies, iris, zinnia, snapdragons, ageratum, chrysanthemums, nasturtiums, daisies, geranium, marigolds, daphne, fatshedra, ivy, tobira, queen sago, broad-leaf acacia.

Hold container 18 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds, or spray at the rate of one liter foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.

**USE WITH CAUTION** on azaleas, junipers, roses, including hybrid tea roses, flowering quince, ash and camellias. These plants may be subject to leaf burn under certain conditions of use. For adult whiteflies and two-spotted mites be sure to direct spray to contact these pests. Thoroughly cover the infested area. Use several repeat applications at weekly intervals if necessary.

**PROTECT HOUSE PLANTS.** Kills aphids, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, two-spotted mites on African violets, rhododendrons, geraniums, begonias. Spray as directed above. Leave the sprayed area when done indoors, and ventilate area after treatment is completed.

**TO KILL NUISANCE PESTS -- ON OR ENTERING BUILDINGS:**

**WASPS:** Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary. Spray directly on stray wasps that enter buildings.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray in ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**SPIDERS:** Direct short burst of spray on spiders and repeat as necessary.

**EARWIGS:** Spray directly on earwigs in crevices and their hiding places, on, out door porches, patios, and in driveway entrances.

**CAUTION**

Shake well before using. Read and follow all directions on the label. Do not use in areas where children or pets are present.

**HOUSEHOLD PEST TO KILL HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS.** Shake well before using. Spray liberally in and around areas where these insects are present. Repeat as necessary. For gnats, spray directly on the insects. For mosquitoes, spray in areas where they are present. Repeat as necessary.

**TO KILL CRAWLING INSECTS** — Shake well before using. Spray directly on crawling insects and in their hiding places. Repeat as necessary. For ants, spray directly on trails and nests. For spiders, spray directly on the spiders. For earwigs, spray directly on the earwigs.

**TO KILL ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray in ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**OUTDOORS -- TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS**

Hold container 18 inches from the infested plants. Spray in short bursts of one to three seconds, or spray at the rate of one liter foot of growth per second. Direct spray to all sides, covering foliage until slightly moist. Avoid heavy wetting. Repeat as necessary to obtain control.
