Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

1. Remove the declaration for other isomers of d-(cis,trans)phenothrin from the ingredient statement and combine its percentage with that active ingredient so that it totals 0.2%.
2. Delete "General Classification." Uses of this pesticide have not been classified.

The formula dated December 4, 1990 is acceptable and has been included in our files for this pesticide.

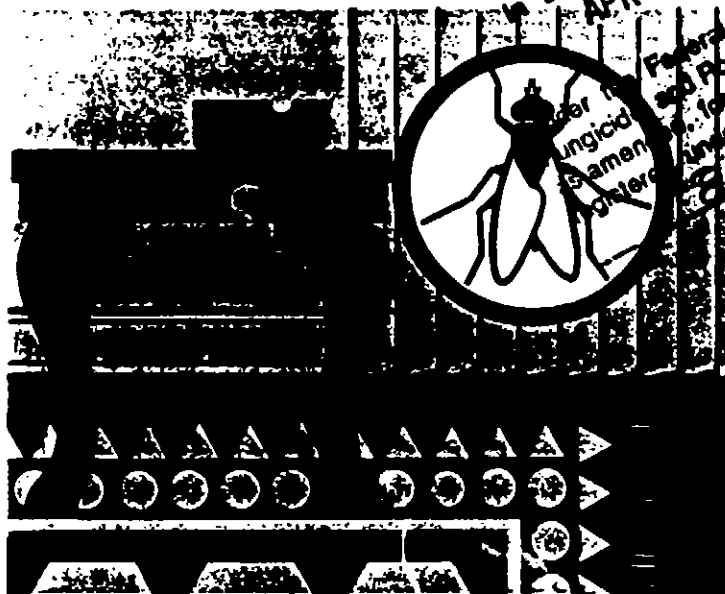

To Kill Fleas: pet's old quarters of window and local areas necessary. fresh bedding spray has cats with product before treated.

To Kill Spiders & Spiders: insects as thoroughly room suspected pests. Spiders paid to crack faces under refrigerator.

To Kill Carpet Beetles: as many insects as both interior stored furniture of rugs thoroughly. Also treat under furniture as insects are pest as necessary.
