To Control **WHITE GRUBS (LARVAE OF JAPANESE BEETLE AND EUROPEAN CHAFER):** Apply 4 pounds of granules uniformly over 1,000 square feet of turf. For best results, treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surfaces, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service for proper time to treat in your area.

After application wash granules into soil with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.

To Control **ANTS, CHINCH BUGS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, SOD WEBWORMS AND SOWBUGS:** Spread granules uniformly at a rate of 1 pound per 1,000 sq. ft. In northeastern states, make first application in May or June or when insects first appear. Repeat as needed, usually in July or August.

To Control **HYPERODES WEEVIL:** Apply granules uniformly at a rate of 2 pounds per 1,000 sq. ft. Make first application of suspected area in mid April, followed by a second application 30 days later.

To Control **BROWN DOG TICKS:** Apply granules uniformly at a rate of 1 pound per 1,000 sq. ft. with special attention to pet resting areas.
