Polates — Early and late blights. Use 2 to 5 level teaspoons per gallon of water. Apply to 500 sq. ft. as soon as plants are 2 to 6 inches high. Repeal at 5 to 10 day intervals as long as blight threatens. Under severe disease conditions, use the shorter interval or the higher dosage rate.

## FLOWERS

Begin spraying when new growth starts or when leaves first unfold. Apply at weekly intervals during season

Carnations: Leaf spot. Pansles: anthracnose. Dahilas: botrytis. Zinnias: leaf spot. Frewering. Dogwood, anthracnose, apply when buds begin to open and again, when bracts fall, and 4 weeks fater, and again in fate summer.

Gladielus: botrytis curcularia. Stemphylium leaf spot. Peony: botrytis and phytophthora blights, apply in early spring and early fall to foliage and to soil around plants, repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals during growing season.
