UsE AESTMICTIOMS - For use against moles and pocket gophers in lawns. golf courses, and other non-crop areas. Do not apply in gardens and areas where food or feed may be contaminated. Only apply the bait under ground. Collect and bury all dead animals found above the ground.
specific ancetions fon moles - The presence of moles may be indiaated by a network of surface ridges in the turf. by a series of conical mounds of earth pushed up from deep burrows. or by damage to bulbs.
 according to on? of the fallowno two neethods. Either press down a small section of the tumition or remove abne inichs section of the tunnel's roof. Mark section of the tungijor regove a ane inchsecuon of the tunners rooi. Mark thattened runway has been raised up or if the root has been repaired. Only treat flattened runway
active burrows.
Carefully punch a hole in the top of active tunnets, drop a teaspoonful amount of bait and carefully close the hole with sod or stone. Do not collapse the runway again or allow loose soil to cover bait. After a few days check to see if the burrows are still active according to one of the two methods described above. If so, repeat treatment.
comical mounis remove center plug from the conical mounds with aid of a long handied spoon and ofop a teaspoonful amount of bait into the underground tunnel. Close opening with rock or sod. Do not alfow loose dirt to cover bait.
BULE PMOTECTIOM - (fatl plawnd Pack about one quarter inch of soll against each bulb. Plate several baits at sides of and around the bulb. Then cover.
SPECIFIC ORECTHOMS FOR PGCKET COPMERE - Burrowing pocket gophers (Thomomys spp. and Geomys spp.) throw out low, fan shaped mounds on either side of their underground tunnel. These lateral tunnels coming to the surface are on the flat side of the fan and are plugged with soil. With a long-handied spoon carefully remove the plug. Insert a fablespoonful amount of bait as far down as possible. Reclose opening, being careful not to cover bait with soil.
