The labeling amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- Under the Environmental Hazards section, change the second sentence to "Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters." Change the last sentence to "Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark."

2. Submit one (1) copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

The subject Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) meets the label claim for the active ingredient, is acceptable, and has been placed in the file for this product. The CSF dated 9/16/91 will be considered the basic CSF and all the previous ones will be considered as obsolete.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

CAUTION: Causes eye and skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Wash with soap and water after handling. Avoid inhaling spray mist. Do not use or store near food or feed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Repeat until fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth.

If on skin: Wash affected area with soap and warm water.

If in eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Consumption of alcoholic beverages increases the toxic effects of thiram.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Drift or runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas. **DO NOT** apply directly to water or wetlands.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

RE-ENTRY

Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried. Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information. Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. Oral warnings must be given if there is reason to believe that written warnings cannot be understood by workers. When oral warnings are given, warnings shall be given in a language customarily understood by workers. Written warnings must include the following information:

CAUTION

(Insert area or field description) treated with Thiram on (insert date of application). Do not enter treated areas without protective clothing until sprays have dried. In case of accidental exposure, call a doctor (physician), clinic or hospital immediately. Explain that the victim has been exposed to Thiram and describe this condition. For further information see the "Statement of Practical Treatment." Oral warnings must include the same information that is in the written warnings.

FOR USE ON TURF:

prevents the infestation of common turf diseases such as Dollar Spot and Brown Patch if sprayed at regular weekly intervals throughout the summer season.

will control Snow Mold when 2 applications are made during Fall through Spring seasons.

will control Dollar Spot and Brown Patch when applied at a higher dosage to turf already infested with these diseases.

PREVENTIVE DOSAGE:

- A. For Dollar Spot and Brown Patch, 3 1/4 lb. ozs. per thousand square feet, at seven day intervals throughout the warm season.
- B. For Snow Mold, 1 1/2 lb. ozs. per thousand square feet late in the fall prior to snow fall. Follow with a spring application of 4 1/2 lb. ozs. per thousand square feet as soon as snow melts.

CURATIVE DOSAGE:

- A. For Dollar Spot and Brown Patch, 2 1/2 lb. ozs. per thousand square feet. Repeat weekly at intervals for 7 to 10 days. Repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals, as necessary.

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STORAGE: Store unused product in original container only. Store in a cool area out of reach of children and animals. Not for storage in or around the home. Protect from excess heat. Do not subject to temperatures below 32°F. Stir or shake before using.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest EPA Regional office for guidance.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
