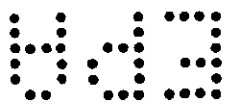

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the labeling.

NOTE THAT THIS PRODUCT IS DESIGNED ONLY FOR APPLICATION IN NON-FOOD SITES.

HOW TO USE: Shake before using. Adjust spray nozzle to give desired pattern. Spray infested surfaces until wet.

TO CONTROL ants, roaches, crickets, earwigs, silverfish and spiders spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms, closets, cracks, crevices, along baseboards, door sills and frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installation. Pests flushed out of hiding should be sprayed directly. For ants: treat ant trails, nests and points of entry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

TO CONTROL fleas and Brown dog ticks (indoors), thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and sleeping/resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Repeat application as necessary. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment of pet area. Do Not Treat Pets With This Product. To control the source of the flea infestation, pets inhabiting the premises should be treated with a product registered for application to animals.

TO CONTROL carpet beetles spray edges of carpeting and under carpeting, rugs, and closets. Make localized application to the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks, crevices, closets and infested areas of shelving and/or wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDOUS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Wash thoroughly after handling. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed—Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If inhaled—Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin—Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If in eyes—Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains petroleum distillate. If gastric lavage is deemed necessary, undertake only after proper placement of a cuffed endotracheal tube. Active ingredients contain a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

Do not spray air in rooms or use on plants. Do not allow spray to contact food, feedstuffs or water supplies. Thoroughly wash dishes and food handling utensils if contaminated with this product. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Remove pets and cover fishbowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated surfaces until surfaces are completely dry.
