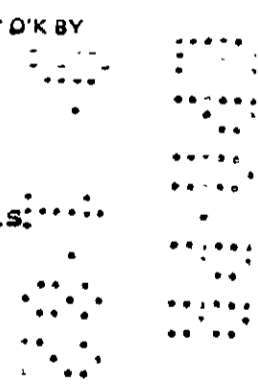

TO OPERATE: Remove protective cap from top of can. Hold can upright, about two to four inches from animal's hair. Point opening on side of valve in desired direction for spray. To release spray, place finger on top of valve and press down. Move the aerosol can over the entire animal (while pressing down on valve), using a "zig-zag" motion, until the animals' coat is slightly damp. On long-haired animals, it may be advantageous to rub the hand against the lay of hair, spraying into the ruffled hair directly behind the hand. Thirty to forty-five seconds is usually sufficient to treat a 30 lb. animal. Repeat treatment as necessary, making sure spray wets ticks. Do not use more often than once every seven days.

Thoroughly spray interior of kennel or other animal sleeping quarters. Also spray bedding and replace with fresh bedding if necessary. Where animal odor is present, spray lightly into the air.

This aerosol can makes a slight hissing sound and causes a temporary cool sensation. Nervous animals may become frightened the first time the aerosol is used, but soon become accustomed to the treatment.
